

Assistant Professor of International or Financial Economics (Tenure track)

The Department of Economics at the Johannes Kepler University Linz is currently inviting applications for a full-time Tenure Track position either in **International Economics or Financial Economics**.

Research: The jobholder is expected to conduct research in the areas of International Economics or Finance of the highest international standard and to publish in leading peer-reviewed journals.

Tenure agreement: The position will be initially limited to a period of 6 years. Job holders will be offered a tenure agreement if the academic performance suggests that the required high qualification can be reached. If the requirements of the agreement are met, employment will be continued for an indefinite period as a tenured Associate Professor. Promotion to Full Professorship is possible.

Teaching obligations: The jobholder will participate in teaching programs at all levels and is expected to take an active role in the ongoing development of the academic programs. The usual teaching load as an Assistant Professor is four hours weekly. Teaching is usually required only during the academic year. After tenure the usual teaching load increases to eight weekly hours.

The Department of Economics offers an environment with an excellent research and teaching infrastructure.

Remuneration: The prospective candidate will be offered an annual gross salary of EUR 51,955.40, overpayment is possible.
