- Independently producing empirical, policy-relevant and innovative analyses and research papers to be published in the OeNB's outlets or external journals
- Contributing to the (further) development of new analytical and monitoring tools, e.g., building and evaluating databases as well as dashboards
- Represent the Oesterreichische Nationalbank (OeNB) in international or Eurosystem working groups and task forces on international macroeconomics
- Producing briefing notes, presentations and ad hoc reports for the OeNB management

- You have in-depth knowledge and experience in theoretical and empirical economics, ideally with a focus on international macroeconomics
- You hold a PhD or a doctoral degree in economics (or are at an advanced stage of a PhD/doctoral program)
- You are able to apply state-of-the-art quantitative research methods, ideally with experiences in analyzing international capital flows and trade, and are a skilled user of databases in this field
- Ideally, you have job-related experience in the field with a track record of policy-relevant work
- You are proficient in standard software packages used in quantitative economic research (R, STATA, MATLAB or Python, etc.)
- You enjoy working in a team of highly skilled experts
- You are a confident speaker and have excellent oral and written communication skills in either German or English and a strong willingness to acquire good knowledge of the other
