This is a full-time position according to Collective Agreement “Uni-KV B1 lit.b.” The minimum monthly salary is € 3.546,00 (before tax, 14 times per year). The position is limited to 6 years. Prospective starting date: **1st March 2016**.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Contribution to the main research area of Microeconomics with a focus on game theory, contract theory and mechanism design theory;
- Independent lecturing at the university as well as supervision of students’ works;
- Independent research and publications;
- Contribution to the departmental research, teaching and administration;
- Organization and acquisition of funded projects as well as participation in departmental re-search projects;
- Substantive and organizational participation in congresses and other departmental events;
- Participation in the management and development of the department as well as its international networks.

Required Qualifications:

- Completed doctoral degree (or expected to be completed before the date of employment) in Economics or related subjects (Mathematics, Operations Research etc.);
- Excellent knowledge in Microeconomics, especially in game theory, contract theory and/or mechanism design theory;
- Proficiency in German and English;
- Demonstrated ability to conduct high quality autonomous scientific research.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Specialization in the field of game theory, contract theory or mechanism design theory;
- High quality peer-reviewed publications;
- Good teaching skills and/or experience in teaching at tertiary level;
- Experience of working abroad;
- Social competence and ability to work in a team;
- Willingness to participate in the research activities of the chair;
- Willingness to participate in shaping the profile of the chair.

The position does not offer the possibility for tenure.
