The professorship in Econometrics and Empirical Economics is a central professorship within the department of Economics at the University of Graz. The successful applicant is expected to be a theoretically well founded econometrician. Her/his main research focus should be either application or theory, or, ideally, both. Econometrics should be comprehensively covered, amongst other things through research in at least two subfields of econometrics and its application, demonstrated through relevant publications in peer-reviewed journals. We expect the successful candidate to engage, cooperate and collaborate with other members of the department, particularly with those who work empirically. We need her/him to teach econometric theory and application in our bachelor's, master's and doctoral programmes in German and/or English and to help with the continuous improvement especially of the master's programme on Political and Empirical Economics, as well as with the development of a PhD programme. We expect both experience with and a willingness for the acquisition of competitive third-party funds from the successful candidate on a national and/or international level. In addition, we expect gender mainstreaming competence.
