

The University of Innsbruck invites applications for the position of a

University Professor
of
Economics in particular Empirical Economics

at the Department of Public Finance at the Faculty of Economics and Statistics.

The position will be based on a permanent civil law employment contract with the university in accordance with § 98, UG 2002 [University Act].

With its Research Platform “Empirical and Experimental Economic Research” the Faculty positions itself as a national and international center for theory-based empirical and experimental economics. With high-standard research achievements that are both internationally recognized and of great societal relevance the Faculty strengthens the university as a research-oriented institution.

Responsibilities

Representing the subject of Economics in teaching and research. The main focus is expected to be in Empirical Economics (in particular applied econometrics).

It is the applicants' responsibility to represent the subject “Empirical Economics” in teaching and research and to contribute to a sustainable development of the Faculty's research landscape, in particular to the Research Platform “Empirical and Experimental Economic Research” and the Research Center “Tourism and Recreation”.

Applicants are expected to teach courses in the Bachelor Program “Economy, Health and Sport Tourism”, the Bachelor Program “Economics and Management”, the Master Program “Economics”, the Master Program “Destination and Regional Development”, and the PhD Program “Economics”.

Participation in academic administration is taken for granted.

Eligibility requirements include

a pertinent degree in higher education, a pertinent ‘habilitation’ [post-doctoral qualification for academic careers] or comparable qualification, excellent publications in international peer-reviewed journals, proven involvement in international research, experience in raising external research funds and distinctive didactic skills.

The University of Innsbruck is committed to increasing the percentage of female employees, especially in leading positions and therefore explicitly invites women to apply. In the case of equivalent qualifications, women will be given preference.

Applications must reach us at the latest by December 21st, 2018 and should include the usual documentation (esp. curriculum vitae, publications list, description of completed, current and intended research, five most important works). All documents have to be submitted via e-mail. The basic salary is set down in the collective bargaining agreement for university employees. Professors are in the remuneration group A 1. For this position the monthly salary before tax is € 5.005,10 Euro (14 x). Depending on qualification and experience a higher salary can be a topic in the negotiations with the rector.
