is vacant and should be filled at the earliest possible date. The position pursuant to § 98 UG constitutes a permanent employment contract under private law. After 4 years, the professorship will be evaluated.

It will be the task of the job holder to represent and contribute to the subject in research and teaching. The detailed requirements are documented in a job profile which can be accessed at <http://www.jku.at/professuren>. He or she should have an excellent academic qualification in empirical research, in particular with regard to the application of microeconomic methods. Sound expertise in a specific field in economics is beneficial

A habilitation or an equivalent qualification in the announced research area is a prerequisite. Next to the professional requirements for the position, a high value is set on the social skills of the candidate.

The Johannes Kepler University aims to increase the number of its female faculty members. Therefore, qualified women are strongly encouraged to apply. In case of an equal qualification, female candidates will be given preference.

The salary will be, as agreed upon on voluntary basis, above the minimum salary of the Austrian collective agreement. Depending on the candidate's current position (salary), the annual gross salary will range from 80,000 € to 100,000 €.

Candidates are asked to send their applications (see link above for detailed requirements) in electronic form to the Rector of the Johannes Kepler University Linz (bewerbung@jku.at) until August 17, 2016, midnight. In case that sending attachments in electronic form is not possible/appropriate, they can be sent in hard copies (five copies) in such a way that they arrive not later than one week after the end of the closing date for applications.
