Economic Assessment of European Climate Policies

\\ 22-23 October 2015, Florence - **Call for Papers**

Florence School of Regulation Climate (FSR Climate) is pleased to announce its 2015 Annual Conference focusing on the *Economic Assessment of European Climate Policies*. The event, which will take place in Florence on 22-23 October 2015, aims to take stock of existing knowledge on the effects of European climate policies, targeting researchers, policy makers and other stakeholders operating in this area.

The conference will cover the main climate-related existing policies, at EU, national and subnational levels and will include the following four sessions, each of them with an invited speaker:

- **EU ETS:** Claudio Marcantonini (FSR Climate, Italy)
- **Carbon/energy taxes:** Ian Parry (International Monetary Fund, USA)
- **Energy efficiency policies:** Massimo Filippini (ETH Zürich, Switzerland)
- **Renewable policies:** Mario Ragwitz (Fraunhofer ISI, Germany)

Martin Weitzman (Harvard University, USA) will give the keynote presentation.

Papers on the above topics will be considered for presentation at the conference. They should be submitted in pdf to FSRClimate@EUI.eu and should include: title, abstract, full text and email address of the author. Submitted papers will be evaluated by the conference Scientific Committee and decisions will be communicated by **20 September 2015**.
